

General House Rules

>	PΙέ	ease read,check box and sign to indicate your understanding and agreement:
		Step work & relapse prevention plan: House members are required to engage and work on their
		individualized recovery plan. Each house member is REQUIRED to join a recovery
		group and obtain sponsor/mentor/guide from said group. Groups must be
		organized and meet weekly.
		Personal Item Requirements: House members are to provid their own bedding, lietries & clothing. We do have clean linen, basic tolietries and clothing available if seded.
		Restriction: There will be a one-week initial restriction upon moving into New Chapter
		Living. No overnights or leaving the premises without permission from the Mentor or
		without a senior house member. Restriction will be lighter but will continue for 30 days
		to allow time to orient to a sober living environment. Work, meetings, family visits, and
		gym will be allowed after the first week but still no overnights or leaving the home
		without permission.
		Curfews: Sunday- Thursday 10pm Friday/Saturday 12am
		Overnights are not permitted within the first 30 days of a house member's stay unless it
		is approved by Mentor. House members will be required to fill out a formal overnight
		request form, which will be either approved or denied. Failure to return to the house
		on time can result in a dismissal of the sober home.
		Daily Chore: All House members will be responsible for DAILY CHORES as assigned and
		scheduled at weekly House Meeting. Cleaning supplies are located under kitchen and
		bathroom sinks.
		Drugs, Alcohol, and Gambling: Use and/or possession of illegal drugs and/or alcohol will
		result in immediate dismissal. If asked to leave for drugs and/or alcohol the house member

	agrees to leave the premises immediately and not return for any reason whatsoever,
	without permission from the Manager or Mentor.
	Smoking: Smoking is only allowed in the back "smoking area" behind the house. House
	members must throw finished cigarettes in the butt can. House members must be quiet
	at smoking areas after 9:00 PM to be mindful of neighbors. There will be no smoking in
	the house or in front of the property.
	Drug Testing: House members are required to submit to a Drug and Alcohol Test
	at any time (24/7) it is requested. They must complete the test within 30 minutes of
	being asked and must not leave visible sight of Mentor. Refusal and/or failure to
	complete the quick cup will be treated the same as a positive test result. We use a 16-
	panel quick cup and complete at least 10 random tests a month.
	Probation/Parole will be notified upon a positive drug test, and if you leave the sober
ho	me.
	Meetings: Weekly attendance at self-help meetings is REQUIRED, 2-3x a week.
	Employment: House members are required to maintain employment within 30 days of
	entering the sober home. At any time, a house member becomes unemployed
	and is capable of working, must actively seek employment from 11:00 am - 3:00
	pm Monday through Friday.
	Personal Belongings: House member's belongings (rooms, vehicles, cell phones, and
	computers) are subject to search at any time. If illegal drugs, alcohol, or weapons are
	found this will result in immediate dismissal from the sober home. New Chapter Living
	is NOT (at any time) responsible for a house member's personal belongings . House
	members are responsible for the security and safekeeping of their own personal items.
	Guests: All guests must be approved by New Chapter Living. Guests of the opposite
sex	care strictly prohibited from entering any New Chapter Living personal bedrooms and are
	to remain in common areas only. <u>Visiting Hours are Fri/Sat/Sun noon to 6pm.</u>
	Quiet Hours: House quiet time is 9:00pm to 6:00 am on weekdays and 12 am to 9:00 am
	on weekends. Any activity (i.e., Lights, TV, Telephone conversations, kitchen use etc.)

	that disturb another House member's ability to sleep/rest is prohibited. Please use			
	common areas within reason.			
	Theft/Violence: Any house member caught stealing from the property or another house	e		
	member will result in dismissal of the sober home . This will be the same for any violen	ce,		
	physical or emotional, directed at Manager, Mentor or fellow house members.			
	House members are not permitted in any bedroom other than their own without			
	permission from the house member(s) residing in that room; they must also be			
	accompanied by the permitting house member.			
	House members are ALWAYS required to wear appropriate dress in common areas.			
	No FOOD or DRINK permitted in bedrooms, with the exception of water.			
	Kitchen Use: Appliances, Counter-tops, Utensils, Dishes, Pots, Pans, etc. will be clean	ed		
	and returned to their respective place (immediately) after each use. Regardless of			
	who's chore it is.			
	All prescribed medications will be stored in an appropriate lockbox and monitored by			
	New Chapter Living during designated medication times.			
OHouse members who must leave the sober home as a result of breaking any of the above mentioned rules, are required to leave the premises immediately and not return. (Only to coordinate picking up their belongings within 7-10 business days of discharge)				
A viol	lation of any one of the Rules & Guidelines will result in a write-up and			
poten	ntial loss of overnight privledges.
